ORDER


NOW, this 20<sup>th</sup> day of April 2020, in accord with the Order of the Pennsylvania Supreme Court dated April 1, 2020, in which, *President Judges are AUTHORIZED to declare judicial emergencies in their judicial districts through May 31, 2020, or for part of that period, should they deem it appropriate based on local conditions for the protection of the health and safety of court personnel, court users, and others.*

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECREED that; the Judicial Emergency declared in the 45<sup>th</sup> Judicial District of Pennsylvania shall continue to exist through May 31, 2020 due to the COVID-19 crisis. All previous Orders of this Court relating to the Judicial Emergency with expiration dates prior to May 31, 2020 shall be extended through May 31, 2020.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other aspects of this Court's Emergency Judicial Order of March 16, 2020 shall remain in full force and effect.
